- handling and observation of fine and precious stones with two gemologists
- observation and presentation with an art historian of antique jewels to illustrate the evolution of jewelry through the ages.

The evening then continues with a cocktail reception in our lounges.

Wine & Gems 12 people

An oenologist and a gemologist guide you in the joint discovery of wine and precious stones.

Team Building Day 30 employees

The morning is devoted to the discovery of the professions at the heart of jewelry creation. The group is divided into 3 sub-groups of about ten people, each following a 2h course in parallel: "Trying Out the Jeweler's Techniques" to learn the gestures of a master jeweler, "Discover the Gemstones" to learn about gemology, and

"Trying your hand at Japanese Urushi Lacquer" to discover an ancestral craft. This is followed by a lunch in the Salon Or organized by one of our caterers.

In the afternoon, we put at your disposal the Salon Blanc for your business meeting.

Training Session 12 employees

As part of a training seminar that you organize, your sales teams come to spend 2 hours at L'ÉCOLE, School of Jewelry Arts to acculturate themselves to a world of excellence and discover how to highlight exceptional savoir-faire in a concrete and hands-on way. After an introduction to the world of jewelry and to the creation process of a jewel, your teams will meet with master jewelers and stone-setters for a demonstration of their savoir-faire and an exchange around their professions.


For groups of individuals





COURSES

L'ÉCOLE offers some 20 classes in both French or English, arranged around three broad themes: Savoir-Faire, History of Jewelry and the Universe of Gemstones.

The classes are very hands-on and there is no prerequisite of knowledge or skills. Each lasting for 2 to 4 hours, they are given by at least two instructors. Whatever their length, all classes are carefully scripted to keep students on the edge of their seats.

Our teaching team is composed of: jewelers, designers, mockup makers, art historians, gemologists, lacquer craftsmen and enamelers.

These experts have an enthusiasm for sharing their knowledge and have all been trained to be excellent teachers.

Courses of 2, 3 and 4 hours From 6 to 16 people maximum depending on the course












THE UNIVERSE OF GEMSTONES


CREATIVE WORKSHOPS for children and teenagers

EXHIBITIONS

L'ÉCOLE has developed about twenty conference themes that you can privatize. With themes such as "Great Jewelry Collectors", "Marie Antoinette's Jewelry", "Rubies, Art and Science" and many others, our talks are moments of exchange and discovery.

In between our temporary exhibitions, our conference room can accomodate up to 70 people. During temporary exhibitions, we can privatize our talks in the Salon Or or Salon Blanc which can accomodate up to 35 people.
